1. Within the session information, you will find the levels and age groups. An age group within a set of parentheses indicates a group for individual awards. Age groups that are grouped with square brackets, denote a group that will combine to form a State's All Star team for that level and age group/s. The number in the "curly brackets" denote the maximum number of gymnasts allotted in that session, the actual number in the session may be less, but not more.
